Community Connection Services is to support those who are in self isolation in the community due to COVID-19 and to meet their needs.

The service include:

- Support emergency food
- Help with an urgent power, gas, heating or water bills*
- Help with other urgent costs*
- Connect to various services and provide information:
 - Help for benefit payments / employment assistance / income related accommodation costs
 - Senior services
 - Community support services
- Others for emergency needs

* It may require some evidence in advance.
